NEW: All Category judges <u>must register in our zFairs online portal</u> (see below).

There are two simple steps to sign up to be a Category judge:

- 1. Go to your zFairs account
 - a. This step is explained in this short 5min video (watch now!)
 - b. If this will be your very first time ever judging at the GSDSEF, you must first create a zFairs account, at <u>gsdsef.zfairs.com</u>. Do NOT reuse your old login and password from a GSDSEF Google account.
 - c. If you have ever been a GSDSEF judge (1955-2022), you already have a zFairs account, which either you created (2021/2022) or we created for you. Go to Step 2. Do not create a new zFairs account.
- 2. Enter your 2023 Judging Preferences
 - a. This step is explained in this second short 5min video (watch now!)
 - b. Use your personalized magic link to log in directly to your zFairs account, with no username and password required.
 - If you are a brand-new judge, this link will be in the email you received from <u>gsdsef@zfairs.com</u> during Step 1 above
 - ii. Otherwise, use the link sent to you in the email
 - c. Complete your account profile and enter your judging preferences, as explained in that <u>second short 5min video</u> (watch now!)

If you cannot judge this year, please let us know by a reply to this message.

Important notes (continued on the next page):

- The GSDSEF Categories changed a bit in late 2021 (aligning with ISEF), so please <u>review the current categories list</u> before entering your preferences
- If you also want to be a Grand Awards judge (formerly Sweepstakes), see that <u>second short 5min video</u> about eligibility and how to nominate yourself

- If you will be a Professional Society judge (or judging team captain), follow the guidance received from Sejal Pabari (sejal.pabari@gsdsef.org) and/or your judging team captain (and see also that second-short-5min video)
- Students will upload a summary slide deck about their project to zFairs, and optionally also a 2-minute video and/or project notebook (PDF), so you will have the option to preview your assigned projects before the Fair
- A detailed judging day agenda and instructions will be sent to you prior the Fair, and also posted in the zFairs portal
